#### SAIGON THE RIVERS EDGE





As Ho Chi Minh City rapidly modernizes, one thing remains constant—life along the edges of the Saigon River. In the adjoining canals, riverboats still ply a route to and from the great Mekong, as they have for centuries. Join us in this bustling waterworld, where you'll find photographic opportunities unlike anywhere else in the city. We start out with a canal-side wander to capture photos of working river life. Tugboats arrive here carrying coconuts and other goods from the Mekong, and we'll document these classic scenes from the Saigonese riverside. The route then takes us past a Buddhist temple and onto a floating village, with rickety houseboats anchored along the path. The owners often come out for a chat, giving us a chance to take portraits and shots of them at work and play. We finish up with a dramatic view of Saigon's 21st century skyline over the river, and a walk through a traditional market offering beautiful light for people photography.











#### ITINERARY



**8:30** am Hotel Pick up and make our way to the "The Coffee Ship" We'll have a coffee while running through the tour and our camera settings. Then it's time to explore the area under the bridge and port, keeping an eagle eye out for tugboats working on the river.

**9:00** am We'll move along the river to take photos looking east and west along the canal, then photograph the old shanty-style buildings along the canal and river boats from above as they navigate the canal. Boats arrive from the Mekong Delta along this canal bringing all kinds of goods, but especially coconuts.

**9:30 am** We'll explore the canal bank and head into a small alleyway leading to Buu Quang Buddhist Temple. This is a great place to chat with locals and do some portraits.

**10:00 am** Next we dive into a narrow but very busy and intense street with interesting characters, as well as shops and markets selling fish, meat, flowers, fruit, vegetables and clothes.

**10:30 am** We'll make a short refreshment stop then return to the Canal where you will see the houseboats and floating market. Now it's time to head in an easterly direction along the waterfront and do some portraits of people selling their produce, fishing, sitting on their boats or having a sleep.

11 am We continue along the waterfront under bridges and into a very old traditional market. We will use the beautiful morning light and capture the many friendly characters in the river market. At the far end of the market we can take in the vast view of the Saigon river, ships in the port and Saigon's city skyline from a very different perspective.

**12 pm** We have lunch, and a quick review of photos before returning to your Hotel by 12:30.
